EDITORIAL Pharma Industry shirks responsibility to ensure place of work of SPEs

The profession of Sales Promotion has always been different than most of the known professions of the society. Although the profession accommodated a large number of young, energetic, educated but unemployed youth of the country, yet the desired recognition as an honorable occupation was seemingly always elusive from the society. There was a time when they were called as 'Canvasser"; a term derogatorily used to degrade the work of an SPE. Then at some time the word "Salesman" came in vogue. Undoubtedly one reason why this section of employees was looked down upon was because they never got the desired level of recognition and respect from the very employers, they spent their life working for. Initially recruited on the basis of sales-commissions, it was the very fire that burned within their collective wills of these people that compelled their employers to recruit them on a perennial basis with salaries and other applicable benefits that come along with it. Further it was because of relentless struggle of these workers under the banner of FMRAI to be recognized as legitimate part of the working class of the country, that the SPEs got the much-needed sector specific act for the first time in 1976, namely The Sales Promotion Employees (Conditions of Services Act), 1976, A slew of other trade union acts followed that also applied to them. Without doubt these laws gave this section of employees the justified legal recognition in India, which further gave way to social recognition to a great extent.

Whatever the above realities might be, there was one place that was always solacing for the SPEs in the pharma industry in India. The chamber of the Doctor was a place where an SPE always received his desired respect, support and recognition. In fact, history says that when the company premises have offered nothing but disrespect and humiliation to an SPE, the chamber of the Doctor was a place where an honest and diligent worker always received the respect he deserved. This respect that developed over time was mutual and bonded into a fraternity that came in support of the SPEs in performing their jobs without impacting patient care services in any way, and also during tough times when SPEs had to struggle against oppressions from their employers. either individually or collectively. It is because of this respectful relationship that the profession got their firm footings in private chambers and also in hospitals and other institutions where Doctors too did their jobs. This entry into the places where Doctors did their duties also compelled the Government to recognize the jobs being performed by the SPEs in these places as "Medical Detailers" in the Magic Remedies and Objectionable Advertisements Act, 1954 through a General Statutory Rule (GSR 843) dated 29th May in the vear1967.

The above provision clearly says that the prohibition of advertisement of certain drugs for treatment of certain diseases and disorders (as mentioned in Section 3 of the said Act) is not applicable to Medical Literature distributed by "medical detailers appointed by manufacturers, importers or distributors of drugs, duly licensed under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 (23 of 1940) and the Rules thereunder". This was done after section 15 of the said Act directed the government to specify allowing advertisements of drugs in "public interest". The lawful recognition of Medical Representatives to work where Doctors also work cannot be more explicit. This lawful identity is exactly something that is being routinely challenged nowadays through various written or verbal orders passed by the hospital authorities restricting or prohibiting SPEs from entering in the places where a doctor is commonly found in an institution.

The above trend was started by some corporate hospitals in the metro cities some of which even charged "fees" from the SPEs to allow them for selected work in their premises! But the most surprising part is that now authorities of even renowned Government hospitals are also following suit. In spite of repeated persuasions by various sub units of FMRAI sometimes the issues are not getting resolved. However, the most important aspect of this entire issues is that the employers, for whom an SPE visits the premises of the hospitals are uncannily silent on the matter. It is as if the entire onus of finalising the place of work lies on the shoulders of the SPE and not on the employer. The truth is, it is the job of the employer to give the employee the place where he could deliver his duties, why should there be an exception in case of sales promotion work? The decision of the places and territories of work as well as the number and categories of doctors to be visited by an SPE are completely controlled by the employers. Yet, it is the observation of FMRAI that throughout the country, whenever and wherever there has been problems of visit of SPEs to Doctors chambers or OPDs, the management of the pharma companies silently bypass even facing the issue and resolve the matter. At the same time the field worker is harassed because of noncoverage of the concerned doctors. This dichotomy in the approach has now become a hallmark of the pharma management. This opportunistic and evasive attitude is beyond any logic: the same employer ensures workplace for a factory worker, provides office for an office worker but takes no step when the workplace of a field worker is challenged. More so when various arbitrary and unethical promotional strategies adopted by the employers are primarily responsible for public and sometimes administrative apathy towards the work of the SPEs. FMRAI therefore demands that the management of the pharma companies must resolve the issues related to restrictions of sales promotion work in hospitals and other places where such situations exist. The industry simply cannot wash away its role of creating the reasons of such restrictions and at the same time hide its face to avoid its duty to ensure gainful work of sales promotion.
